Dr. Beate Hörr has been Director of the Center for Continuing Education at the University of Mainz, Germany, since 2000; her original profession is comparative literature and theatre studies, she was guest lecturer for the German Academic Exchange Service in Colombia in 1997 and 1998 for Jewish Literature and she was head of the international office at the University of Freiburg until 2000; she has been responsible for all the LLL programmes at the University of Mainz and has lead several LLL projects with national and international partners. For example she has been partner in the IMPLEMENT project lead by EUCEN (<http://implement.eucen.eu>).

She has been involved in strategic institutional processes, for example in the establishment of a quality assurance system within the area of LLL. Her research-based activities focus on quality assurance in Leading Learning Institutions and Learning in Later Life.

She has been elected as the president of the German national network for lifelong learning (www.dgwf.net), after being member of the board for many years; she has been board member of the federal association for Learning in Later Life and member of the senate of her University, the Johannes Gutenberg-University of Mainz.
