Ph.D. in Adult Education (University of Montreal), Dr in Educational Sciences (University of Strasbourg), Prof Jerome Eneau worked during 20 years in industry as a trainer and then as a training manager, before joining the University of Strasbourg (France) in 2004. He was then in charge of vocational training and human resource development program (Master degree) and responsible for an e-campus (distance learning for continuing education), as a teacher at the University of Lyon (2005-2009).

He has been teaching since 2009 at the University of Rennes (France) as a Professor in Adult Education, where he is in charge of the co-direction of the CREAD (Centre de Recherche sur l'Education, les Apprentissages et les Didactiques) and a Master degree program in adult education.

His research interests include adult education, autonomy and self-directed learning. It focuses specifically on the study of social dimensions of the adult education and self-directed learning (reciprocity and gift-giving exchange, cooperation and collaboration, recognition, trust and credibility, etc.).

He is the author of two books in French and various chapters and articles published in French, English and Spanish.
